1 Inclusive communities






2 Health, housing and wellbeing

In 2018 we

 made a survey to see what the community think about disability



 helped schools become more inclusive and accessible.

Accessible means a place where everyone can get in and move around.



In 2018 we

 asked the government to change building rules so new houses are more accessible




 gave money for projects to help Aboriginal people with disability.

asked health services to make a disability action plan




 made better rules for safe housing for people with disability.

In 2018 we

- ran projects to teach people with disability about health and sickness
 - for example, dental health



• gave money for workshops about autism



- helped make kinder garten programs more inclusive for children with disability
- helped Parks Victoria work with more people with disability



 made sports and activities inclusive for people with disability in Victoria.



In 2018 we gave 26 million dollars to help the disability workforce move to the **National Disability Insurance Scheme**.

The National Disability Insurance Scheme is called the NDIS.



The NDIS helps people under 65 with a disability get

care



• supports.

 gave 20 million dollars to help people move to the NDIS.

In 2018 we gave money for disability advocacy services.



Advocacy services help people with disability get access to human rights.



In 2018 we gave money to a study to learn about family **violence**.

Violence means someone hurts you.



Violence might be physical.

For example, someone hits you.



It is also family violence when children

hear the violence

• see the violence

• know about the violence.



In 2018 we made plans to

 get information about family violence in new ways



• stop abuse of people with disability.


Abuse is when someone hurts you.

talk about important topics like disability




 decide what to do to help people with disability in the community.


What we know about people with disability in 2018
